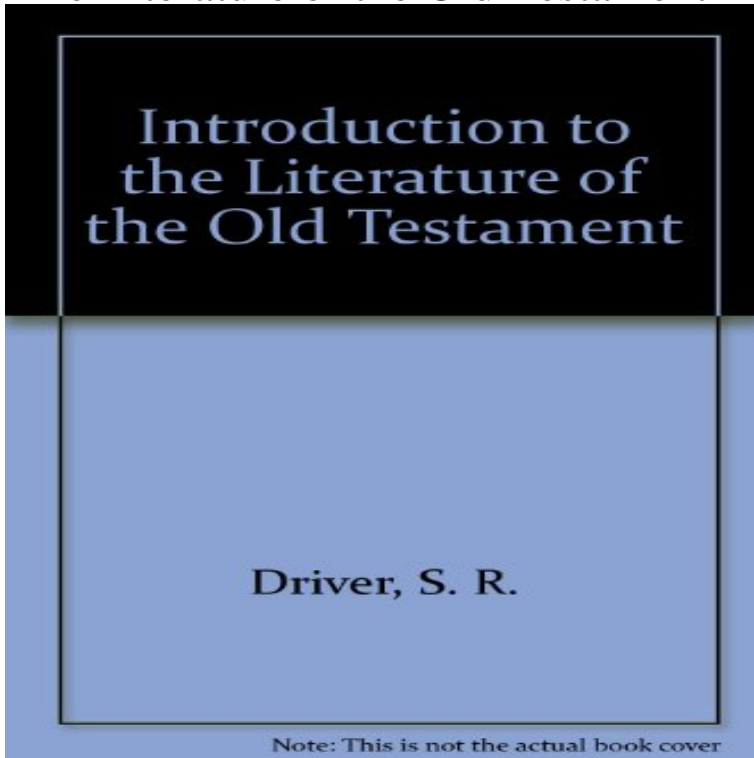


# The Literature of the Old Testament
